Equipment:

- Pencil
- Small craft iron
- Ironing mat
- Spray starch & small container with resealable lid
- Stencil brush 1/4"
- Ultimate Appliqué Template Paper
- Appliqué Pressing Tool
- Appliqué Stiletto
- Black Identia pen, or fine-point Sharpie
- Fiskar small curved scissors
- Fabric scissors
- Roxanne's Glue Baste It
- Aleene's OK to Wash It Glue
- 1/4" Clover bias maker
- Thread Heaven
- P3 Designs Petite Needle Threader
- P3 Designs Straw Needles #11
- Assorted colors, 50wt DMC fine machine embroidery thread, or your favorite thread

Fabric Requirements:

- 1/2 yard lt background fabric
- 3/4 yard dk blue for 1st border and binding
- 1/4 yard red for flowers, scallop and circles
- 1/2 yard lt blue for 2nd border
- 10" squares assorted fabric squares for applique
