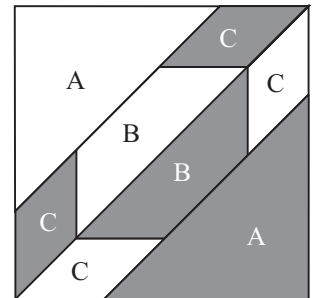

<b>Backing</b>	3 1/4 yards	5 1/4 yards	7 3/4 yards

<b>Background - Light</b>				
<b>A</b> 7 1/4" squares	12 (3 strips)	24 (5 strips)	40 (8 strips)	cut once diagonally
<b>B</b> 2 3/8" strips	24 (4 strips)	48 (8 strips)	80 (14 strips)	cut into trapezoids in class
<b>C</b> 2 3/8" strips	48 (5 strips)	96 (9 strips)	160 (15 strips)	cut into diamonds in class
<b>Dark Blues - Assorted</b>				
<b>A</b> 7 1/4" squares	12 (3 strips)	24 (5 strips)	40 (8 strips)	cut once diagonally
<b>B</b> 2 3/8" strips	24 (4 strips)	48 (8 strips)	80 (14 strips)	cut into trapezoids in class
<b>C</b> 2 3/8" strips	48 (5 strips)	96 (9 strips)	160 (15 strips)	cut into diamonds in class
<b>First Border</b>				
1 1/2" strips	5 strips	7 strips	9 strips	
<b>Final Border - sides</b>				
	2 - 6 1/2" x 60"	2 - 6 1/2" x 78"	2 - 6 1/2" x 96"	
	2 - 6 1/2" x 54"	2 - 6 1/2" x 72"	2 - 6 1/2" x 90"	
<b>Binding - 2 1/2" strips</b>	6 strips	8 strips	10 strips	



**NOTE** - I highly recommend the use of spray starch to give the fabric a crisp finish! This is especially helpful when piecing bias, and finger pressing.

When cutting strips as directed above, please cut the strips from selvage to selvage. Each resulting strip will measure approximately 42" long. If you are using fat quarters, extra fabric will need to be allowed because of loss due to the fabric being only 21" wide. The strips will be cut into trapezoids and diamonds in class!

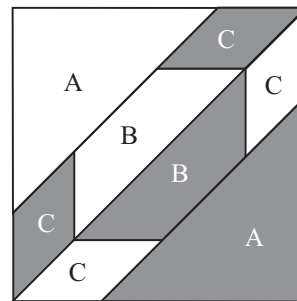
**Fabric Requirements**    Prewashed, Pressed with Spray Starch, and Precut!!!

<b>Wall Quilt</b>	<b>Lap Quilt</b>
50"square	86" square
36 6" blocks	36 12" blocks

<b>Assorted Lights</b>	1 ½ yards	3 1/2 yards
<b>Assorted Darks</b>	1 ½ yards	3 1/2 yards
<b>First Border</b>	½ yard	5/8 yard
<b>Final Border</b>	1 ¾ yards	2 ¾ yards
<b>Binding</b>	½ yard	¾ yard

## Cutting Instructions - see note below

	Wall Quilt	Lap Quilt	Special Directions
<b>Assorted Light</b>			
<b>A</b> 18 squares	5 1/8"	9 3/8"	cut once diagonally
<b>B</b> Trapezoids	5 strips 1 3/4"	9 strips 3"	cut strips into 36 trapezoids - Template B
<b>C</b> Diamonds	5 strips 1 3/4"	9 strips 3"	cut folded strips into 72 diamonds - Temp C
<b>Assorted Dark</b>			
<b>A</b> 18 squares	5 1/8"	9 3/8"	cut once diagonally
<b>B</b> Trapezoids	5 strips 1 3/4"	9 strips 3"	cut strips into 36 trapezoids - Template B
<b>C</b> Diamonds	5 strips 1 3/4"	9 strips 3"	cut folded strips into 72 diamonds - Temp C
<b>First Border</b> 1 1/2" strips	4 strips	8 strips	
<b>Final Border</b> - sides	2 - 6 1/2" x 40" 2 - 6 1/2" x 54"	2 - 6 1/2" x 76" 2 - 6 1/2" x 90"	
<b>Binding</b> - 2" strips	5 strips	9 strips	



**NOTE** - I highly recommend the use of spray starch to give the fabric a crisp finish! This is especially helpful when piecing bias, and finger pressing.

When cutting strips as directed above, please cut the strips from selvage to selvage. Each resulting strip will measure approximately 42" long. If you are using fat quarters, extra fabric will need to be allowed because of loss due to the fabric being only 21" wide. The strips will be cut into trapezoids and diamonds in class!
