The Ivy wreath pattern, Project fabric (top, backing and binding)
Batting and Thread

Supply List:

To make 4 practice sandwiches (pin baste 2 of these)

2 yards of muslin, cut into 18" x 22" pieces

4 pieces of batting, 18" x 22", 80/20 blend, or Hobb's Wool batting

1 spool of lightweight Thread, any light color other than ivory (60/2 wt. cotton,
60 wt. Bottom Line by Superior Thread, or 50/2 Aurifil)

Water-soluble marking pen (new)

Small fabric scissors or curved blade Snips

50 to 100 (gold or silver) safety pins (small, 003, 004 work well)

Masking Tape

Sewing machine needles, size 70 Microtex (sharp)

Sewing machine with owner's manual, foot control, power cord, and extension
cord, smallest free-motion and/or darning feet, slide-on tray or extension
table and 1 or 2 empty bobbins.

*Bring your BEST, cleaned and oiled sewing machine in good working order. You
will benefit from practicing with the lightweight and invisible threads before class.

*If you are renting a machine you will need to notify the dealer that you need the
smallest free-motion foot and an extension table or slide on tray and an empty
bobbin.
