Mark quilting designs without ever having to cut a stencil. Draft one-of-a-kind feathered quilting motifs, or alter commercial patterns to fit your quilt, then transfer them to freezer paper, and use the prepared marking guide to mark borders or blocks for quilting. This technique was featured in Elsie's book "Winning Stitches" published by C&T Publishing, 2004. Design class. All skill levels. No sewing machine required. 3 hours.
