Here's a great way to have fun with your fabrics – ALL of them. Even "uglies" add sparkle to this fun, lively scrap quilt. Come with extra fabric to swap during class!

You'll Learn about:

- Working with value and contrast
- Rotary cutting strips and squares
- Super techniques for machine piecing with speed and accuracy
- Pressing tips
- Multiple design ideas for nine patch quilts

You'll get:

- Illustrated cutting, piecing and pressing directions
- Yardage and block charts for crib through king size quilts
- Quilt layout diagrams

Supply List:

__ 20 different 100% cotton quilting fabrics

- If you come with 20 different pre-cut 6" squares, you'll have plenty to keep you busy in class, but you will need additional fabric to complete a quilt top.
- Scraps are ideal as long as they're no smaller than 6" square.
- Think about bringing extra pre-cut 6" squares or fat quarters so you'll have fabric to trade.
- Try for an assortment of lights, mediums and darks. Don't worry about coordinating colors.
- Aim for variety prints, batiks, solids, plaids and stripes are all great. The more fabric choices you have, the better!

Rotary cutter (medium or large size) and cutting mat
Rotary cutting ruler (best sizes are at least 6" square or 6" x 12" or 6"x24"
Neutral colored thread
Basic sewing supplies: pins, small scissors, extra machine needles, etc.
Pencil for taking notes
(optional) flannel/batting and masking tape for a portable design wall
